

District level Workshop Report

Community Based Monitoring & Planning of Health Services

Date 18/10/07

Place: Ashagram Trust Barwani

Introduction

On 18 Oct 2007, a district level work shop on Community Based monitoring of Health services was organized jointly by Ashagram Trust and SATHI at Ashagram Trust training hall. The main objective of organising this workshop is to communicate the community monitoring concept with and within the main stakeholders who would be the monitored by the community for better functioning of the health services. Ashagram is a district nodal agency of Barwani for this programme. Sathi – Cehat will provide technical assistance to the programme. Community Monitoring will be facilitated by the Ashagram through a team consisting one district facilitator (at district level) and three block facilitators (for three revenue blocks PATI,PANSEMAL,BARWANI) (See annexure -1). District Mentoring team consisting seven members (social works, health activists, lawyer and health official) has been formed earlier. It will mentor the programme and will work as a pressure group on govt. functionaries and provide necessary support at district and block level to nodal agencies. District and block facilitators will facilitate the process of formation of committees and would be responsible for capacity building as well as training of these committees, liaisoning with health, ICDS, and PRI functionaries. Committees will not only monitor the health services but also develop health plans at their level. Documentation and reporting process would be done by the committees with the help of facilitators and resource persons from village to block via PHC, and block to district.

Participants

All the peoples or stakeholders who could be directly or indirectly concerned or involve in the process were invited. In the district level workshop of Community Based Monitoring of Health Services following govt. officials participated. Mr. Ashok Bhargav (CEO Zila Panchyat Barwani), Dr. R.S. Dudve (CM&HO, Barwani), Dr. A. Vishnar (D.I.O. District Immunisation Officer), Dr. Bharat (M.O., Rosar), (Pati, Barwani), Dr. C.S. Rosalya (B.M.O. Pati, Barwani), Dr. S. Chowhan (B.M.O. Sendhwa)

Agenda for the workshop

It was a kind of sensitization as well as launching of the programme of Community Based Monitoring of Health services at district level. This workshop was organized for the sensitization of health and others govt. departments. Almost all the officials were attended the workshop. CMHO and Zila panchayat CEO Suggest some recommendations for the programme.

Following were the agendas of the workshop with brief out lines;

- **What is community Monitoring of health services?**
 - Mr. Dhananjay kakade (Sathi Pune) a resource person for Barwani district for the process of community monitoring presented the concept. Activities or functioning of health and ICDS department would monitored by the community. The process would be done through the committee at village, PHC, Block, District and state level.
 - Health, ICDS, PRI's, local community members SHG's and CBO/NGO functionaries or activists would be the main stakeholders of this process at village to state level.

- Community would monitor as well as develop a health plan at their respective levels.
- **What would be the role of Health Department In the process of Community monitoring of Health services?**
 - Dr. R.S. Dudve (CM&HO, Brawani) ensured during his address that that full cooperation would be given by the health department and necessary orders would be given wherever is necessary.
- **What would be the Role of PRI's In the process of Community Monitoring of Health Services?**
 - Mr. Ashok Bhargav (CEO of Zila Pandhaya) appreciated to the programme and recommended that more sensitization need to be done at village and block level for Aanganwadies and others PRI's members.
 - Silawad BMO recommended that District mentoring team members, or District and block facilitators could attend **Block CHC's or PHC's meetings**. Generally it is organized ones in a month. *It would be helpful to sensitization and dissemination of information and would be helpful to incorporate more peoples of health dept. in the process of community monitoring.*
- **What would be the role of CBO/NGO's and District Mentoring team in the process of Community monitoring of Health services?**
 - Nandani Oza (District Mentoring team member) said that meeting of district should more participate in the process. A meeting of district mentoring must be organized ones in a month to know the progress of the programme and must visit at block and PHC's.
- **Structure of activities of community monitoring process at different level.**
 - Community monitoring programme would be implemented in Barwani, Pati, and Pansemal block of Barwani district. There are 45 villages under 9 PHC's of these three blocks.
 - At village level village health and sanitation committees would be formed. At PHC block, district and state level monitoring and planning committees would be formed. These committees would work as a chain process.
 - The whole process will be look after by block and district facilitators. These would be full time paid persons. They would be responsible for, formation of committees, dissemination of information, training and coordination at village PHC block district and state level.
- **Conclusion**

People's health lies in people's hand. Success of any programme lies in the process of people's participation. Community monitoring is just a step taken forward toward more and more people's participation in the field of health. Participation of health and ICDS department is really appreciable but disappearance of elected representatives like president and other members of Panchayat need to have more sensitization at this level.
